

QUICK RULES - PLEASE READ THIS FIRST

Be kind and use clean words. Walk, play safely, and follow staff directions. Do not fight, bully, steal, damage things on purpose, or use sexual, hateful, or threatening words or pictures. Tell staff about injuries, spills, broken items, or danger. Rule-breakers may have to leave and lose their Pass without a refund. You may have to pay documented costs for damage you cause on purpose.

4. YOUR BASIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- Keep Game On family friendly. No profanity, slurs, sexual or threatening language, harassment, bullying, fighting, or offensive conduct.
- Follow posted rules and staff directions. Walk, use equipment only as intended, and stop any unsafe activity when asked.
- Do not steal, tamper with, misuse, or intentionally damage games, furniture, equipment, prizes, food-service items, or another guest's property.
- Report injuries, spills, broken equipment, missing pieces, theft, or unsafe behavior to staff right away.
- You are responsible for your conduct, your personal property, and documented direct costs for damage you intentionally, willfully, or maliciously cause, as allowed by law.
- Pass sales are final and nonrefundable except where required by law. Rule violations may result in removal or Pass suspension or revocation.

HEALTH, ACCESS, AND SAFETY NOTE

Arcade games may use flashing lights, screen motion, and loud sounds. Board games may contain small pieces. Pool and ping pong involve moving balls, cues, and paddles. Choose activities that are appropriate for your health and abilities, follow posted warnings, and ask staff about reasonable accessibility modifications when needed. Game On does not provide medical monitoring or personal supervision.

OPTIONAL: SAFETY, ACCESSIBILITY, ALLERGY, OR EMERGENCY INFORMATION STAFF SHOULD KNOW

Read every section before signing. These rules support a safe family environment. They do not remove any legal right that cannot be waived.

5. GAME ON FAMILY-FRIENDLY RULES

- Use respectful, family-friendly words and behavior.
- No cussing, foul language, slurs, sexual language, threats, harassment, or offensive displays.
- No bullying, fighting, rough play, intimidation, or unwanted contact.
- No stealing, hiding, damaging, or taking Game On or another guest's property.
- Follow staff directions, posted signs, age limits, and time limits.
- Walk inside. Do not run, chase, climb on furniture, or block exits and walkways.
- Keep food and drinks away from games and equipment unless staff allows them.
- Do not interfere with another guest's game or use.
- No illegal activity, intoxication, or conduct that threatens safety.
- Tell staff promptly about an injury, spill, theft, damage, or unsafe condition.

6. SAFE USE OF GAMES AND EQUIPMENT

- Arcade and playroom: use controls and equipment gently; do not hit, shake, climb on, unplug, or move machines.
- Pool: cues and balls stay at the table; do not swing cues, throw balls, sit on tables, or take equipment away.
- Ping pong: paddles and balls are for table play; keep a safe distance from others while swinging.
- Board games: keep pieces together; small pieces may be a choking risk and require age-appropriate supervision.
- All activities: watch for cords, stools, tables, other guests, moving balls, and items on the floor.
- Stop using damaged equipment and notify staff. Do not attempt repairs or open machines or cabinets.

7. ACTIVITY RISK AND LIABILITY NOTICE

Activity risks. Arcade games, the playroom, pool tables, ping pong, board games, seating, food areas, and movement through the facility involve ordinary risks. These may include slips, trips, falls, collisions, strains, impacts from balls, cues or paddles, pinched fingers, small-piece choking hazards, flashing lights, loud sounds, equipment malfunction, and the actions of other guests.

Adult release. I voluntarily participate and accept the ordinary and inherent risks that remain even when reasonable care is used. To the fullest extent allowed by Arkansas law, I release Game On, its owners, and employees from claims arising from those inherent risks or ordinary negligence connected with the activities. This release does not cover gross negligence, reckless or willful misconduct, unsafe conditions unrelated to the activity that Game On knew or should have addressed, or any right that cannot legally be waived.

8. PROPERTY, EMERGENCY, SERVICE, REFUND, AND PRIVACY NOTICES

PROPERTY, LOSS, AND EMERGENCIES

Damage. To the extent allowed by law, I will pay Game On's reasonable, documented direct repair or replacement cost for damage I intentionally, willfully, or maliciously cause, excluding normal wear, pre-existing damage, or equipment failure.

Personal items. I am responsible for my belongings and will report loss or theft promptly.

Emergency. Game On may call 911 immediately. Staff will reasonably try to notify my emergency contact without delaying aid. Responders decide care or transport. I am responsible for provider charges as allowed by law.

SERVICE, REFUNDS, AND PRIVACY

Lawful refusal or removal. Game On may deny entry, stop an activity, suspend or revoke a Pass, or require a guest to leave for rule violations, refusal of staff directions, unsafe or disruptive conduct, theft, damage, nonpayment, or another lawful reason. Rules follow civil-rights and disability-access laws.

Final sale. Passes are final and nonrefundable except where law requires or Game On does not provide the purchased service. Discipline for a violation creates no refund right.

Privacy. Data is used for Pass administration, safety, emergencies, rule enforcement, and legal duties. See gameonarky.com/privacy or email hello@gameonarky.com for access, correction, or deletion.
